Food Services

Paediatric & Women's Wards

- Patients in the Paediatric & Women's Wards are offered a selection from a range of 15-20 cold and hot meals for lunch and dinner
- A continental breakfast is provided in the dining room for Women's Wards 7 & 8
- A standalone pantry on each of these wards supports patient meal requirements
- In addition to the ward pantry, the beverage bay located in the patient lounge is available 24 hours per day, seven days per week for patients and their families to access hot and cold beverages and snacks
- Food services staff support these wards seven days per week between the hours of 0630 – 2000
 - Meal ordering is undertaken by the JKWC Diet Monitor at the patient bedside on tablets using the CBORD menu management system
 - Ward Food Services Assistants (FSA's) reheat, plate and deliver meals
 - All dishes and trays are washed and maintained within the ward pantry
 - FSA's order stores on a prescribed frequency to support their ward and these are delivered by the kitchen store person
- Meal Delivery times are as follows:
 - Breakfast: 07:00 – 08:30
 - Lunch: 12:00 – 13:30
 - Dinner: 1700 – 18:30

Theatre, Birthing and the Maternity Assessment Centre (MAC)

- Staff working in Theatres, Birthing and the MAC can request food delivery for patients via the Main Sunshine Hospital Kitchen

Newborn Services

- Staff working in Newborn Services can request breakfast for parents/guardians staying overnight in the rooming-in bed spaces prior to their neonate's discharge.
- Meal ordering for the parents is completed via the Main Sunshine Hospital Kitchen
- All other parents who elect to stay with their neonates should source their own meals
