



Frequently Asked Questions – February round 2 (26/2/2019)

Will children's Allied Health move?	Yes, Children's Allied Health will be located on the ground floor of the JKWC, co-located with the Paediatric and Neonatal Specialist Clinics.
What happens with surgical lists if they are half children/half adult?	There will be dedicated children's surgical lists to provide surgical service for children in the JKWC.
Where will emergency gynaecology be?	All gynaecology surgery (elective and emergency) will be provided in the JKWC.
When will the dry run/mock moves happen, particularly in reference to food services?	Various patient scenarios and the mock move are currently planned to occur in April. Food services will have opportunity to test workflows and complete food trials in the new pantry once they have been set-up in late April/early May (dates to be advised).
Will JKWC staff come down and pick up the patients from ED if they're moving from ED to Children's Ward?	Yes. There is a dedicated 24/7 paediatric clinical support and retrieval nurse in the JKWC children's ward. This nurse will facilitate retrieval of paediatric patients from the ED.
Will the new 'staff parking' facilities also encompass volunteers?	Yes. The new staff car parking will also be accessible for volunteers.
Will the children's escort age remain the same with the move?	Yes. There will be no changes to the escort age.
