



## Joan Kirner Women's and Children's Quick Reference Guide

### Ground Floor – Paediatric & Neonatal Specialist Clinics & Paediatric Allied Health

- Paediatric Ambulatory Services are located on the Ground Floor and are divided into two clinic areas with one shared central reception; Clinic A and Clinic B
- **Clinic A comprises:**
  - Paediatric Medical Specialist Clinics, Paediatric Surgical Specialist Clinics, and Neonatal Specialist Clinics
  - Collocated, integrated multidisciplinary team clinics
  - 16 consult rooms
  - Two interview rooms
  - Two treatment rooms, including one plaster room with three bed bays
- **Clinic B comprises:**
  - A new paediatric allied health services model to support a level 6 facility and with a focus on early intervention
  - Standalone paediatric allied health clinics, including audiology
  - Seven therapy rooms, including one large therapy gym and one room fitted with a one-way viewing window and therapy observation system for clinical observation to support assessment provision, teaching, training and education of staff, students and families
  - Two audiology booths and one audiology auxiliary room
- Electronic check in kiosks are available for children and their families attending clinics on Ground Floor
- There is a designated main reception and main patient waiting area, with sub-waiting areas to support clinic flow, and access to an outdoor play area and an interactive play wall in the main waiting foyer
- Staff Facilities:
  - Ground Floor staff lounge with lockers and toilets accessible via swipe card access
  - Hot desk facilities, meeting spaces and education rooms
