



Joan Kirner Women's and Children's Quick Reference Guide

Level One - Women's Ambulatory Services

- Women's Ambulatory Services are located on Level One and are divided into three clinic areas; Clinic A, Clinic B and Clinic C
 - **Clinic A comprises:**
 - Maternity Specialist Clinics, Gynaecology Specialist Clinics, Immunisation Clinics and the W&C Referral Management Centre
 - 28 consult rooms (including two physio rooms and one immunisation room)
 - Two antenatal education rooms
 - Two diabetes education rooms
 - Two interview rooms
 - Two treatment rooms
 - Two colposcopy rooms
 - One urodynamics room
 - One procedure room
 - One immunisation room
 - **Clinic B comprises:**
 - The Early Pregnancy Assessment Service (EPAS)
 - Four consult rooms
 - One procedure room
 - **Clinic C comprises:**
 - Maternal Fetal Medicine (MFM), Genetics and the Integrated Ultrasound Department
 - Ten ultrasound rooms
 - Four consult rooms
 - One interview room

- The Pathology Collection Centre and Satellite Pharmacy are both located on the Ground floor
 - There are 'Clinic Lifts' which operate between the Ground Floor and Level One to assist with patient access
 - Electronic check in kiosks are available for women attending clinics on Level One
 - There is a designated main reception and main patient waiting area, with sub-waiting areas to support clinic flow
 - Staff Facilities:
 - Level One staff lounge with lockers and toilets accessible via swipe card access
 - Hot desk facilities, meeting spaces and education rooms
