



## Joan Kirner Women's and Children's Quick Reference Guide

### Level Three – Birthing and the Maternity Assessment Centre (MAC)

- The MAC and Birthing are co-located on Level Three of the JKWC
- The MAC encompasses current operations of the Pregnancy Day Stay Unit and Pregnancy Care Centre
- The MAC provides care for all pregnant women  $\geq 16$  weeks gestation and postnatal women  $\leq 6$  weeks postpartum
- All unplanned presentations to the MAC will undergo a triage assessment by a midwife
- The MAC contains:
  - Eight short stay rooms
  - Seven fetal monitoring cubicles
  - Five assessment rooms (one assessment room will function as the dedicated triage room)
  - Four chair bays with recliners
  - Three consulting rooms
- Birthing contains:
  - 20 birthing rooms (four with birthing pools). Each Birthing room has a partner bed
  - Two High Care Unit (HCU) beds
  - One bereavement room with an adjoining family lounge
- Staff Facilities:
  - Level Three staff lounge with lockers and toilets accessible via swipe card access
  - Hot desk facilities and meeting spaces
