Levels Seven and Eight – Women's Inpatient Wards

- There are two 32-bed Women's Wards, located on Levels Seven and Eight of the JKWC. On opening:
 - Level Seven will open 24 Maternity beds and 4 Gynaecology beds
 - Level Eight will open 28 Maternity beds
- To support the provision of care in accordance with the Colour My Care model, when possible, women allocated to the yellow and blue teams will be admitted to Women's Ward Seven and women allocated to the purple and orange teams will be allocated to Women's Ward Eight
- Each ward encompasses:
 - 32 inpatient beds (16 single rooms and 8 double rooms)
 - Two negative pressure isolation rooms, one DIAMOND room (for women with increased BMI) and two double observation rooms on each ward
 - One treatment room, a baby bath room and a milk room
 - An indoor/outdoor room for patients and their families
- Each patient room has an ensuite, a day bed and an inbuilt baby bath
- Staff Facilities:
 - Level Seven staff lounge with lockers and toilets accessible via swipe card access
 - Level Eight staff lounge with lockers and toilets accessible via swipe card access
 - Hot desk facilities and meeting spaces
